Visitors to the trail located behind the Pine Hill School will see a wooden kiosk that holds the colorful trail map and tells the story of this little trail that has been maintained for nearly fifty years. That kiosk and signage was made possible by the Sherborn Fund. The Sherborn Fund has been a quiet resource for our community since 1994.
